TRUSTEE REPORT - Tracy Van Raes

BUSINESS COMMITTEE: \$2.067 million surplus, of which \$1.5 millions is internally restricted. \$500,000 in a contingency fund. \$1.028 transferred to caplital, \$300,000 will go to technology, \$680,000 to long range facilitie, & \$30,000 to trades.

LONG RANGE FACILITY & SHATFORD BUILDING UPDATE: Shatford building is not up to code, it will be brought up to code. Board is working hard on long range facility plans. Ideas are being brought forward and then will be shared with stakeholders/parents. A lot of work being done before the public engagement portion. Board will keep us updated as this is not an overnight decision. Board has finished the Long Range Strategic Plan. Daycares are being worked on, Columbia's anticipated completion date is May 2024, Wiltse & Updlands in 2025.

<u>EDUATAION COMMITTEE UPDATE: -</u> Did a deep dinve into understanding what is being done as a Distrit to COVID reltated literacy & numeracy issues. Hired Literacy & Numeracy teachers to help staff understand what is needed. Myron Duick talked about new reporting orders.
